This month, we are reading *How to Fail at Flirting* by Denise Williams.






Take-and-Make Craft: DIY Ceramic Teapot Flower Planter Thursday, August 24 Registration Required.





## 2023 Explore Outdoors Pass for Onondaga County Parks! Available at the Marcellus Free Library for patrons 18 years+

We have 2 passes available for three days check-out. The passes are good for: Beaver Lake Nature Center, Highland Forest, Rosamond Gifford Zoo (valid for up to four visitors), Jamesville Beach Park and Oneida Shore Park, and Pratt's Falls Park. Passes are available on a first come basis; will not be available to place on hold or renew.

**Check out an Empire Pass with your library card** for 7 days and visit New York State Parks for free! The Empire Pass will be available on a first-come basis and will not be available to place on hold or to renew once borrowed. You must be 18 years old to borrow an Empire Pass.
