




Live music is back at the Marcellus Free Library!

Hike down to the Library to pick up your **Reading Register Packet.** Start reading. Write down the picture books, chapter books, e-books and audio books you have completed in your Reading Register (log book).

Beginning June 28, for the next six weeks, log your picture/chapter/e-book and audio book totals via the Summer Learning (READsquared) link on the Marcellus Library website (marcelluslibrary.org).

Points awarded for all books read will automatically enroll you in a random raffle for various STEAM oriented prizes (raffle occurs at the end of the Summer Learning Experience).
